Hospital-acquired Infections in Pennsylvania

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OVERVIEW

In January of 2004, the Pennsylvania Health Care Cost Containment Council (PHC4) began to collect data on hospital-acquired infections (HAIs) confirmed and submitted by Pennsylvania hospitals. Data collection began with indwelling catheter-associated urinary tract infections, ventilator-associated pneumonia, central line-associated bloodstream infections, and surgical site infections for procedures related to orthopedic surgery, neurosurgery, and surgery associated with the circulatory system. The data collection requirements have gradually been expanded over a period of several quarters. As of January 1, 2006, hospitals were required to submit data on all hospital-acquired infections, except those associated with systemic infection; eye, ear, nose, throat, or mouth infection (including upper respiratory infections); and surgical site infections that were not associated with a procedure code listed in Appendix D. See Appendix A for a summary of data collection requirements and their associated time frames.

This document, the *Technical Notes*, accompanies the *Hospital-acquired Infections in Pennsylvania* report, which provides hospital-specific data on hospital-acquired infections to the public. This report includes two sections that present the following information for general acute care facilities: 1) a section that reports calendar year 2006 data, including the new infection types for which collection began in 2006, and 2) a section with Quarter 4, 2005 and Quarter 4, 2006 comparative data.

Consistent with the notion that we should all strive toward a goal of zero infections, the information in this report is based on actual, rather than risk-adjusted, numbers. Concerns regarding risk-adjustment were addressed in two ways. First, patients being treated for burns, undergoing organ transplants, or being treated for complications of an organ transplant were excluded from the report, because they may have been at a greater risk of acquiring an infection while in a hospital. Second, hospital peer groups were created to ensure that hospitals offering similar types and complexity of services and treating a similar number of patients are displayed together.

The 2006 section of the report includes information on all required HAIs that hospitals confirmed and reported for calendar year 2006. Information is provided for the following infections that were contracted while in the hospital: urinary tract infections; pneumonias; bloodstream infections; surgical site infections; gastrointestinal infections; other infections, which include bone and joint, central nervous system, cardiovascular system, lower respiratory system (other than pneumonia), reproductive system, and skin and soft tissue infections; and multiple infections. The following measures are included:

- Number of cases with and without hospital-acquired infections
- The hospital-acquired infection rate per 1,000 cases
- The number and percent of mortalities
- Average length of stay in days (mean and median)
- Average charge (mean and median)

The 2005 *Hospital-acquired Infections in Pennsylvania* report emphasized the importance of comparing a hospital's rates over time, rather than comparing hospitals to one another. However, comparing a hospital's performance between 2005 and 2006 is complicated by the expansion of the HAI data collection requirements phased in during this time frame. Thus, the current report presents limited comparative information by displaying the most similar data collection time periods: Quarter 4, 2005 and Quarter 4, 2006. Numbers and rates for urinary tract infections, pneumonias, bloodstream infections, surgical site infections, and multiple infections are included in this section of the report.

The following pages of the *Technical Notes* describe the data collection process and the methodology of the analyses.

DATA COLLECTION AND VERIFICATION

The Pennsylvania Health Care Cost Containment Council (PHC4) is mandated by state law to collect and disseminate health care data. The data for PHC4's report on hospital-acquired infections was submitted electronically on a quarterly basis to PHC4 by Pennsylvania general acute care (GAC) hospitals as directed by the data submission requirements of Act 89 of 1986 (currently Act 14 of 2003). The data submitted by hospitals included demographic information, hospital charges, diagnosis and procedure codes, and HAI codes. Facilities were required to submit data to PHC4 within 90 days from the last day of each quarter. The standard verification process included extensive quality assurance and data quality checks. Error reports were then generated and returned to each facility with an opportunity to correct any problems.

In developing the guidelines for HAI data submission, PHC4 adopted the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC's) definition of a hospital-acquired infection: an infection is a localized or systemic condition that 1) results from adverse reaction to the presence of an infectious agent(s) or its toxin(s), and 2) was not present or incubating at the time of admission to the hospital. The CDC's hospital-acquired infection surveillance system, known as the National Health System Network (NHSN) includes 13 major site categories that define the hospital-acquired infection location. PHC4 expanded this list to include a category for multiple infections and to differentiate device-associated and non device-associated infections. When a patient had more than one hospital-acquired infection, the patient was reported only once in the multiple infection category, rather than counting each of the individual infections. The HAI type was identified by a two-digit code (see Appendix B for a list of codes). Hospital personnel entered the relevant HAI code when a hospital-acquired infection was present. Hospital-acquired infections were only required to be reported in the admission in which the HAI manifested; readmissions due to an HAI were not required to be reported. Hospitals were required to report HAI data for all inpatient discharges, except where the patient was one year of age or younger and/or the case was assigned to Major Diagnostic Category (MDC) 19 Mental Diseases and Disorders or MDC 20 Alcohol/Drug Use and Alcohol/Drug-Induced Organic Mental Disorders. Hospitals were not required to report systemic infections; eye, ear, nose, throat, or mouth infections (including upper respiratory infections); and surgical site infections that were not associated with a procedure code listed in Appendix D. See Appendix A for a summary of data collection requirements and their associated time frames.

For Quarter 4 of 2005, hospitals were required to report the following types of HAIs:

- Urinary tract infections (device- and non device-associated)
- Pneumonias (device- and non device-associated)
- Bloodstream infections (device- and non device-associated)
- Surgical site infections related to (ICD-9-CM procedure codes are listed in Appendix D):
 - Circulatory system
 - Neurosurgery
 - Orthopedic surgery
 - Endocrine system
 - Gastrointestinal system
 - Genitourinary system
 - Reproductive system
 - Respiratory system
 - Skin and soft tissue
 - Hemic and lymphatic system

For Quarters 1 through 4 of 2006, the requirements for reporting HAIs were expanded to include the following infections in addition to the infections listed above:

- Bone and joint*
- Central nervous system*
- Cardiovascular system*
- Gastrointestinal system
- Lower respiratory system* (other than pneumonia)
- Reproductive system*
- Skin and soft tissue*

STUDY POPULATION

The study population for the report included inpatient discharges from general acute care (GAC) facilities in Pennsylvania for Quarter 4, 2005 through Quarter 4, 2006. Hospitals that were identified as a facility type other than GAC (e.g., specialty GAC, long term care hospital) for one or more quarters of 2006 were excluded from the study population. Duplicate records were excluded from the analysis; if a facility submitted more than one record for a quarter with the same control number, patient birth date, admission date, and discharge date, only the record with the most information was retained for analysis. Cases for which HAIs were not required to be reported were also excluded. That is, patients one year of age and under and/or the cases assigned to MDC 19 Mental Diseases and Disorders or MDC 20 Alcohol/Drug Use and Alcohol/Drug-Induced Organic Mental Disorders were excluded.

Of the cases that were required for HAI data collection, burn patients, organ transplant patients, and patients with complications of an organ transplant were excluded from the report. These patients, due to the nature of their condition, may have been at a substantially higher risk of developing an HAI. See Appendix C for a list of the ICD-9-CM diagnosis and procedure codes that defined the exclusions. The following table provides statewide study population detail.

HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTION MEASURES: CY 2006 DATA

The 2006 section of the report provides volume, mortality, length of stay, and charge information for cases with and without HAIs for calendar year 2006. Information for cases with HAIs is presented at the aggregate level and by the following HAI categories: urinary tract infections, pneumonias, bloodstream infections, surgical site infections, gastrointestinal infections, other infections, and multiple infections. If fewer than five cases were evaluated, the number of cases and the HAI rate are reported; however, mortality, length of stay, and charge information are not reported.

Number of Cases

The report displays the total number of cases that met the study population criteria, the aggregate number of HAIs in the analysis, the number of HAIs in each infection category (e.g., urinary tract infections, surgical site infections), and the number of cases that did not have a HAI. The following table provides detail on the cases with HAIs that were excluded from the CY 2006 analysis.

Hospital-acquired Infection Rate per 1,000 Cases

For all HAI rates, except surgical site infections, the rate per 1,000 cases was calculated by dividing the number of HAI cases by the total number of cases with and without an HAI infection and multiplying by 1,000. For example:

Cases with HAI rate:

$$\frac{30,237 \text{ (number of HAIs)}}{1,574,170 \text{ (total number of cases)}} \times 1,000 = 19.2$$

Urinary tract infection rate:

$$\frac{13,635 \text{ (number of urinary tract HAIs)}}{1,574,170 \text{ (total number of cases)}} \times 1,000 = 8.7$$

For surgical site infections, only cases with one of the ICD-9-CM procedure codes in Appendix D relevant for the quarter in which the patient was discharged were included in the denominator.

Surgical site infection rate:

$$\frac{1,671 \text{ (number of surgical site HAIs)}}{401,257 \text{ (total number of surgical cases)}} \times 1,000 = 4.2$$

Number and Percent Mortality

The number and percent mortality are the number and percent of patients who died during the hospitalization. All in-hospital deaths were counted in this analysis, regardless of the cause of death. The deaths of patients with HAIs were not necessarily related to the hospital-acquired infection.

Average Length of Stay in Days

Both the mean and median length of stay in days are reported. The length of stay for each patient was calculated by subtracting the admission date from the discharge date. The mean was calculated by summing all of the length of stay values in a particular category and dividing by the number of cases in the category. The median is the middle value in the particular category; if there were two middle values, the mean of these two values was computed. Note that differences in the average length of stay between patients with and without HAIs were not necessarily caused by the hospital-acquired infection.

Average Charge

Both the mean and median charge are reported. The mean was calculated by summing all of the charge values in a particular category and dividing by the number of cases in the category. The median is the middle value in the particular category; if there were two middle values, the mean of these two values was computed. Charges do not reflect professional fees (e.g., physician fees) and do not necessarily reflect the amount that a hospital is reimbursed. Note that differences in the average charge between patients with and without HAIs were not necessarily caused by the hospital-acquired infection.

HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTION MEASURES: QUARTER 4, 2005 & QUARTER 4, 2006 DATA

The Quarter 4, 2005 and Quarter 4, 2006 data provides some limited comparative information by displaying the two most similar data collection time periods. The number and rate of infections are presented at the aggregate level for urinary tract infections, pneumonia, bloodstream infections, surgical site infections, and multiple infections. Note that, the expansion of the data collection requirements effective Quarter 1, 2006 increased the opportunity for multiple infections to be counted, which may have corresponded to decreases in another infection type. For example, in Quarter 4, 2005 a patient with a surgical site infection and a gastrointestinal infection was counted in surgical site infections, because collection of gastrointestinal infections was not required until Quarter 1, 2006. In Quarter 4, 2006 this patient would have been counted in the multiple infection category. This may have resulted in increased rates for multiple infections and decreased rates for surgical site infections that were not related to actual changes in the number of infections present.

Number of Cases

For Quarter 4, 2005 and Quarter 4, 2006, the report displays the total number of cases that met the study population criteria, the aggregate number of all HAIs included in the analysis (i.e., urinary tract infections, pneumonias, bloodstream infections, surgical site infections, and multiple infections) and the number of HAIs in each of these infection categories. The following table provides detail on the cases with HAIs that were excluded from the analysis.

Hospital-acquired Infection Rate per 1,000 Cases

For all HAI rates, except surgical site infections, the rate per 1,000 cases was calculated by dividing the number of HAI cases included in the analysis by the total number of cases in the study population for the quarter and multiplying by 1,000.

For surgical site infections, only cases with one of the ICD-9-CM procedure codes in Appendix D relevant for the quarter in which the patient was discharged were included in the denominator.

PEER GROUPS

The four peer groups identified in the report were developed so that infection data for hospitals with similar characteristics would be displayed together. Hospitals were grouped according to the complexity of services offered, the number of patients treated, and the percent of surgical procedures performed. The hospitals using electronic surveillance to identify hospital-acquired infections and submit data are included in the four peer groups. The quarter that each hospital began using electronic surveillance to identify HAIs is noted in the report. The electronic surveillance hospitals were identified through hospitals' responses to PHC4's inquiry regarding the use of electronic surveillance.

Peer Group 1 includes hospitals that provided more complex services than Peer Groups 2, 3, and 4. Hospitals that were designated as trauma centers are included in this group. All of the hospitals in Peer Group 1 performed open heart surgery. They treated an average of 25,430 patients a year. On average, 39 percent of these patients underwent surgical procedures.

Peer Group 2 includes hospitals that provided more complex services than Peer Groups 3 and 4. All of the hospitals in Peer Group 2 performed open heart surgery. They treated an average of 11,000 patients a year. On average, 34 percent of these patients underwent surgical procedures.

Peer Group 3 treated an average of 7,400 patients a year. On average, 24 percent of these patients underwent surgical procedures. None of the hospitals in Peer Group 3 performed open heart surgery.

Peer Group 4 hospitals treated an average of 1,950 patients a year. On average, 18 percent of these patients underwent surgical procedures. None of the hospitals in Peer Group 4 performed open heart surgery.
