Dear Mr. Volavka:

The Bloomsburg Hospital has reviewed the PHC4 data and is responding to the mortality data "rate significantly higher than expected" for Diabetes-Medical Management.

Diabetes alone was not responsible for the mortality rate in these cases. Chart review of the three cases reported in the mortality analysis revealed the following:

- Every case presented with multiple co-morbid conditions
- Diabetes may have been the presenting condition, however it was not the condition causing death
- Each individual case had requested the physician to order "DO NOT RESUSCITATE"
- The cause of death in each case was listed as an acute event and/or infectious process

To summarize, these were individuals who had multiple, complicating conditions attributing to their demise.
